PRAYER OF ST. EPHRAIM

This is a prayer in which we ask God to give us a spirit of repentance. We ask Him to help us recognize the things we do wrong and to change them.

This prayer is especially said during Great Lent, the time of preparing before Pascha--the Feast of Christ's Resurrection from the Dead.

In between each of the verses, we make a prostration. (Kneel, and touch our head to the floor).

As always, say this prayer--and any others--before an icon.

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O Lord and Master of my life, Take away from me the will to be lazy and to be sad; Take the desire to get ahead of other people, to boast and brag.

Give me, instead, a pure and humble spirit, The will to be patient with other people and to love them.

Let me realize my own mistakes And keep me from judging the things other people do.

For You are blessed now and forever. Amen.

Then Father tells me that it is time to tell my sins to Christ, while he stands next to me and helps me.

Then I tell him about the times I did not love God and others.

Father listens and he understands. He is big now, but once he was a child like me.

Sometimes we talk about these things and try to figure out how I can change and be more like Jesus.

> I tell him and God how sorry I am that I have sinned.

Then the priest says the words of forgiveness that

I have been waiting to hear.

IT WAS GOD WHO FORGAVE DAVID THROUGH NATHAN THE PROPHET, WHEN HE CONFESSED HIS SINS, AND PETER WEEPING BITTERLY FOR HIS DENIAL AND THE SINFUL WOMAN IN TEARS AT HIS FEET, AND THE PUBLICAN, AND THE PRODUGAL SON. MAY THAT SAME GOD FORGIVE YOU ALL THINGS, THROUGH ME A SINNER, BOTH IN THIS PRESENT WORLD, AND IN THAT WHICH IS TO COME, AND SET YOU UNCONDERWED BEFORE HIS DREAD JUDGMENT SEAT.

AND NOW, HAVING NO FURTHER CARE FOR THE SINS WHICH YOU HAVE CONFESSED, GO IN PEACE.


