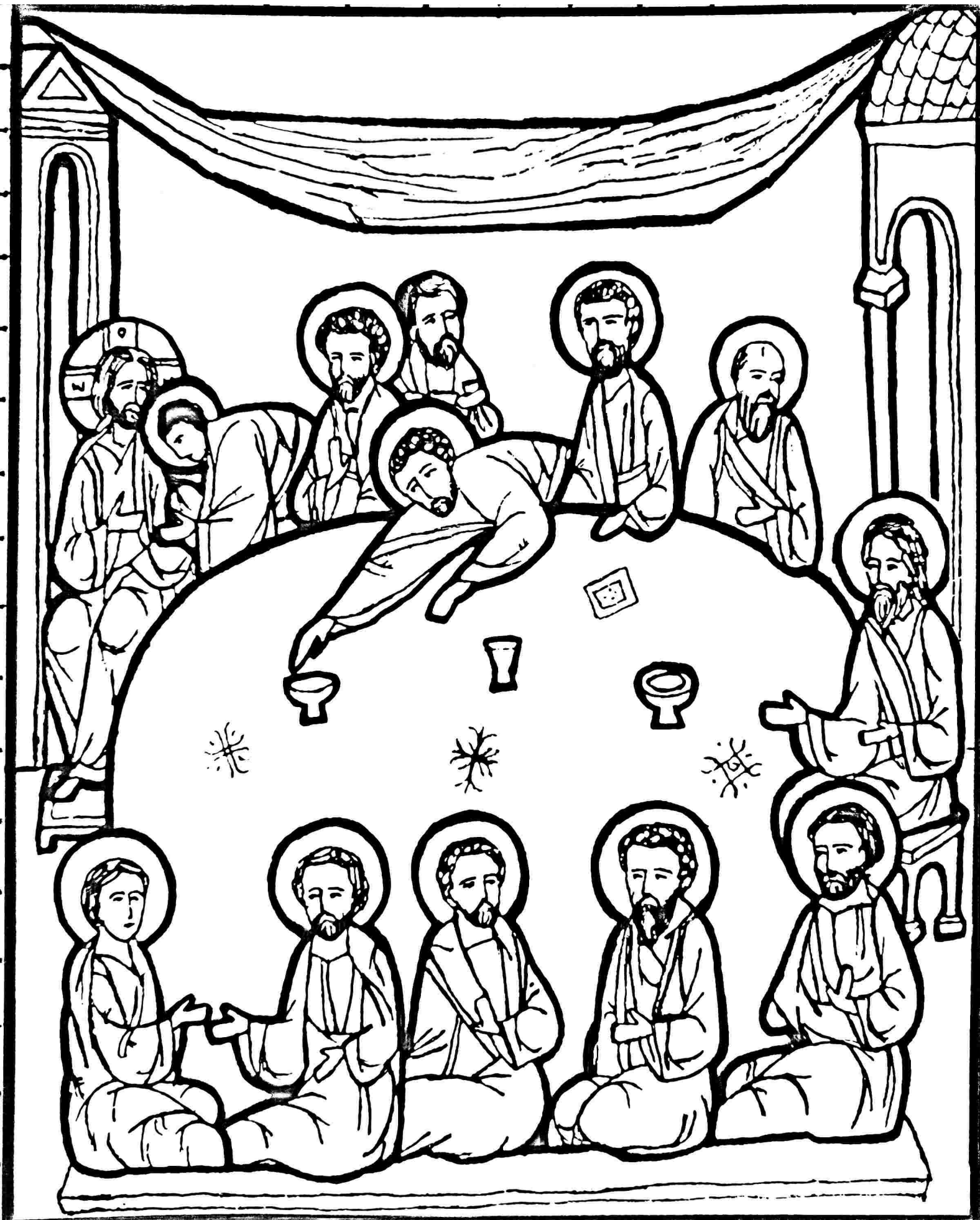

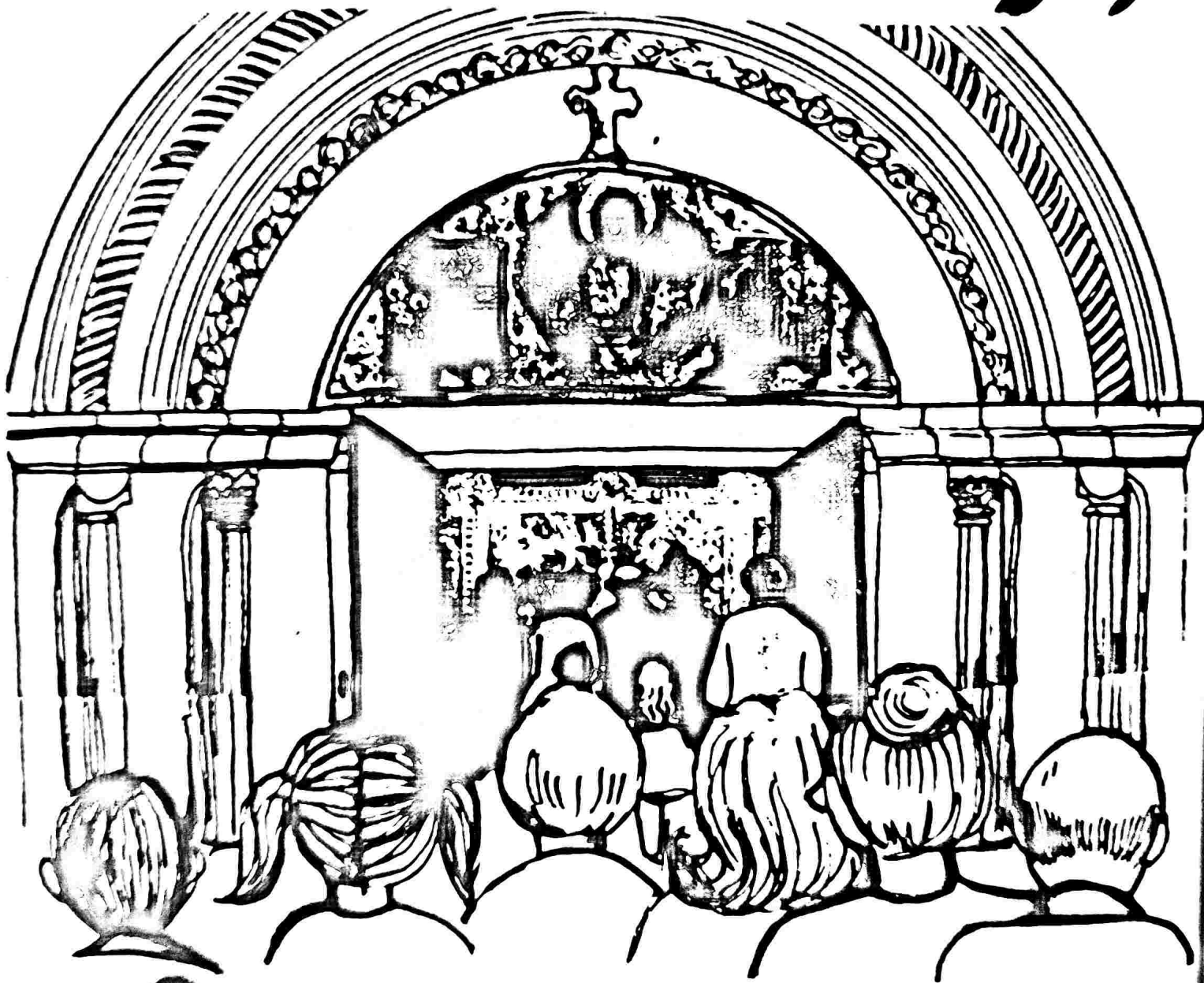

happy life.

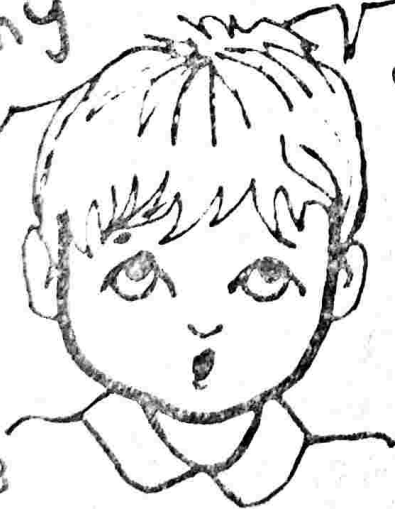
