Orthodox Christians.



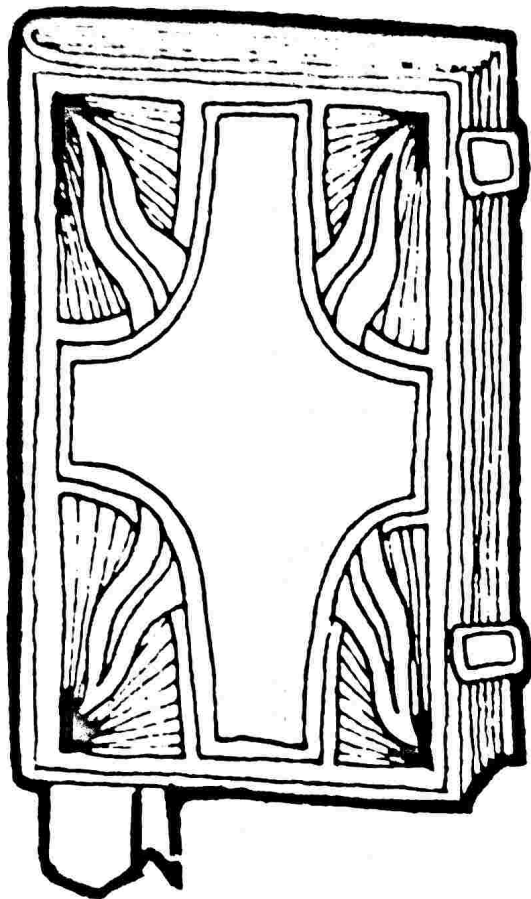
# Alleluia

After listening to the Epistle, we sing "Alleluia."



"Alleluia" means "Praise God!"

The Gospel

"Good News"



What is

News?

God loves us! He  
sent His son to us  
to show us how to live  
and to love God. God

That is "Good News." 13.

As the priest reads the Gospel, he stands in front of the Royal Doors. Altar boys with lighted candles, stand by the Gospel to show how important this reading is.

St. Matthew, St. Mark, St. Luke, and St. John. The Gospels tell us about Jesus's life and teaching

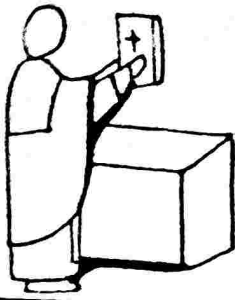
